this email is to kindly draw your attention to the 3rd edition of the “Summer School in Nuclear Physics and Technologies”, which is organized by the University of Ferrara (Italy) and by the University of Texas at Austin, in collaboration with the National Institute of Nuclear Physics (INFN).

The Summer School introduces concepts and technologies in the field of nuclear Physics and environmental monitoring, with a particular focus on radioprotection, nuclear security, Naturally Occurring Radioactive Materials (NORMs), nuclear medicine, nuclear reactor Physics, technologies and industrial applications related to the nuclear development, radioactive waste management, radioactive fallout and radiochemistry.

Lectures will be held in English and will comprise classroom teaching, group laboratory activities, didactic seminars concerning frontier subjects and carrier guidance meetings.

The School will be held at the Department of Physics and Earth Sciences of the University of Ferrara (50 km from Bologna, Italy) from May 31st to June 29th, 2018 and is intended for students not attending a PhD program and having at least a bachelor degree in a scientific discipline.

Registrations are open until February 28th.
